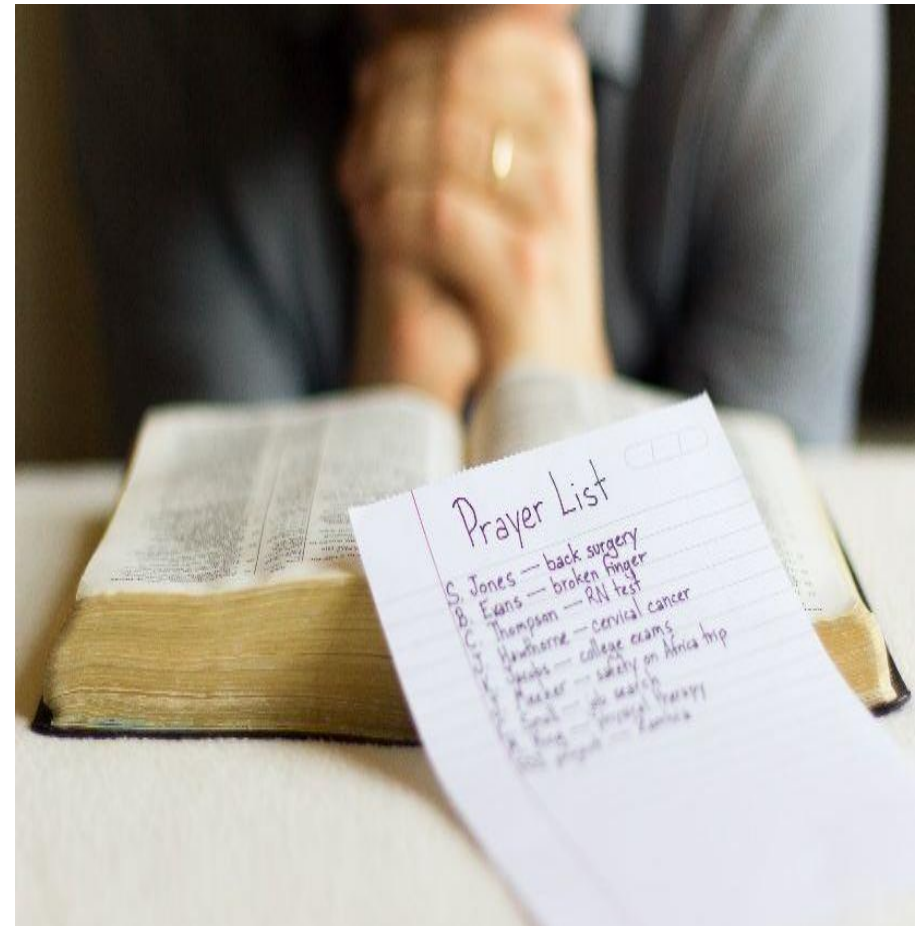

Giving Thanks

If God leads you to do this, you could go through this walk more than once as you pray for different members of the group. Or you could pray for more than one in each section.

Spend some time giving thanks to God for each person in your group, or for your group in general. Let God's love draw you into love for them.

God's Point of View

Ask God to give you discernment of an issue that someone in your group may be facing. Ask Him to show you a similar situation in someone else's life, or in the world, to use as an example to your friend.

If it helps, write down your prayer. You may find it helpful to read the words to another person.

Being straightforward

'When you pray, don't heap up empty phrases like the pagans do...Matthew 6:7

God desires that we ask, so that he can give. Pray in accordance with the eternal perspective God has. Ask exactly what your friend needs as he shows you. Don't dress it up in flowery words.

Intercede

Imagine yourself standing in the throne room of God, with Jesus standing next to you and your friend before the Father. Jesus is sharing your prayer with you.

Pray alongside Jesus. Let Him take your 'straightforward' prayer and present it to his Father. Listen to the conversation.

Adoration

Spend the last part of this walk in praise and adoration of God, giving thanks that your prayer is being heard in heaven and making a difference in the spiritual and physical realms. Pray a blessing on your friends.
