Give us TODAY

In Matthew 6:34, Jesus tells those listening to His Sermon on the Mount:

"Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

It is important to let God be the Lord of today before we look to tomorrow. Jesus, I give you this worry right now - please take care of it for me.

Our DAILY Bread

In Greek, this phrase could literally translate, *"the bread of ours necessary for existence for today."* There is what is "needed"; there is what is "wanted." Amazingly, God DOES care about both.

"Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart." Psalm 37:4

After you have delighted in Him, pour out your heart to the Lord.
