The theme of DFC's annual conference in May was prayer and cooperating with the Holy Spirit in our lives and ministries. We felt a strong call to teach and encourage people to lead in prayer.

It was a day of joyful expressions of how God is doing this in Canada: Trish teaching on intercession from things she learned at Mary Ellen's 2007 Workshop, and how she applied it to training intercessors for Brampton's Ignite. The two intercessors she brought to help us 'on the wall'. Kim who spent hours Thursday night praying over and setting up *Walk* areas where people could sit, read scriptures, pray, and reflect on what God is saying to them. 
