**The next Dunamis Project Event, *In the Spirit's Power*, in Guelph, Ontario on November 11 – 15, 2009**, is an opportunity to explore more deeply the Spiritual Gifts that God has given to each person and learn more about cooperating with the Holy Spirit. ## *Annual Conference Prayer Highlights*

The theme of DFC's annual conference in May was prayer and cooperating with the Holy Spirit in our lives and ministries. We felt a strong call to teach and encourage people to lead in prayer.

It was a day of joyful expressions of how God is doing this in Canada: Trish teaching on intercession from things she learned at Mary Ellen's 2007 Workshop, and how she applied it to training intercessors for Brampton's Ignite. The two intercessors she brought to help us 'on the wall'. Kim who spent hours Thursday night praying over and setting up *Walk* areas where people could sit, read scriptures, pray, and reflect on what God is saying to them. Prayer teams (from many churches) fitting 16 prayer sessions in between lunch and 4 p.m. A participant who risked sharing she felt God was calling intercessors to stand and accept God's call. And all of you who came, connected, learned, listened, risked, trusted, prayed for each other, and responded to God's calls on your lives.

Believing ministry begins in prayer - this is evidence of great things to come.

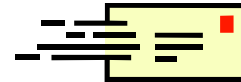
